Two groups of LED lights are placed in the hall of Dordtyart. The LED lights flicker on an irregular basis and fill the hall with blue light. The lights can easily be seen from outside during night. Inside the building they appear more subtle during daytime. They create the illusion as if someone is welding steel.

The artwork connects to the historical aspects and former function of the building. The space was used as a factory for ship engines. During that time factory workers were welding all day long. After the season during wintertime when the hall is closed to the public the light installation will be still working.
